2019 SAM Champs RC Rules Addenda

In general: Unless otherwise specifically stated, all model entries and events shall be in accordance with the current AMA competition safety rules and the January 2015 printing of the SAM Official Rule Book.

Radio Equipment: No information is required on the list of event entries. Most pilots are expected to operate radios on 2.4 GHz and will not require frequency control pins. However, a carousel with numbered pins will be in use and pilots operating radios on discrete channels must have the appropriate pin in place on their transmitters. Pilots operating radios in either of the two ham bands must also use the pins and have a current FCC Amateur Radio license available on the field.

Speed 400: Two special events are scheduled in addition to the standard championship event on Wednesday. On Monday the special Speed 400 event will limit the motor run to 90 seconds and flights to 10 minutes max. On Tuesday the second special Speed 400 event will limit the motor run to 120 seconds and flights to 10 minutes max. Only the standard Speed 400 (180 seconds 15 minute max) event scheduled for Wednesday will receive electric championship points. Rulebook specifications apply to all Speed 400 models and motors. All events will score the best two of four flights. Participants present at the pilots' meeting will decide on mass launches of first flights.

Brown Junior Events: Un-scaled Antique models of any wingspan and any fuselage configuration may be entered in either or both events without restriction.

Concourse d'Elegance: All models should have completed the required demonstration flight by Wednesday evening. A written statement in confirmation of that flight will be presented to the Concourse Director and accompany the model at the time of entry.

The Roberts Trophy resides permanently in the AMA Museum. It will be awarded to the pilot having the longest single flight of the week in any of the following three events:

Texaco Glow , Spark Ignition Texaco , and Classic Texaco .

The Speed 400 Scale event follows the Speed 400 rules for power, weight, scoring, LMR, etc. Entries are scale models of man carrying aircraft designed prior to 1951.

E36 Electric Replica is a special RC event sponsored by SAM 100. Models are Old Timer gas designs with max wingspan of 36 inches. Motors, etc. are unrestricted. Batteries are two cell lipo.

LMR is 90 seconds; the best two of three max flights of 10 minutes are scored.

Rescheduling of events due to weather will assign priority to championship events.
